

DUMP TRUCK INSTRUCTIONS

Please check that you have all parts. (Located in attached bag)

- 5 ground stakes
- 2 wing bolts
- 1 pkg of asst. color clips (replacement)
- 1 black 2 point controller (may be already attached)

Unfold display being careful not to stretch any attached wires. There are two pieces to the Dump Truck. One is whole Dump Truck. One is Dump bed with no front of the truck. There are hinges on the whole truck. Attach two small metal plates at hinges together by screwing wing bolt into metal plates to hold up display. Make sure bolt is on opposite side of the nut which is attached. Do not screw bolt into the side with the nut first.

Attach ground stakes by screwing them into the bottom provided slots. You may need an adjustable wrench.

Dump Truck may possibly need extra support which is not included. You can do this with an extra stakes placed behind the display, driven into the ground, and tied to the frame using a twist tie or a cable tie. Push ground stakes of whole dump truck gently into the ground. You can do this with your foot and using a back and forth motion to inch each side gradually into the ground. Then directly behind of this whole dump truck, place the bed only. Attach two together with cable tie or twist tie.

1. Plug front section of the whole dump truck into an extension cord. This male plug is not marked.
2. Plug controller into an extension cord.(not included.)
3. There are two male plugs at the bottom of each dump bed marked either Green 1 or Red 2.
4. Plug Green 1 into Green 1 on the controller. Plug Red 2 into Red 2 on the controller. Adjust speed to your liking. ***see below about polarization issues.

*** If you plug any of these into the controller and the light does not come on, for example, you plug up Green 1 to Green 1 and the lights do not come on, you need to turn that plug around. Some controllers have a polarity issue. IF the polarity is crossed it will not light. So by turning the prongs around, it will line up the polarity and the lights will come on. We have also placed a dot on the controller plug and a dot on the decoration plug. If you line these dots up, then it will keep the polarity straight.

For the best look, straighten clips. Also, if you live in an area with lots of rain or snow, you may want to take extra precaution to cover your controllers. See our website for ideas on how to protect your controller.

Dump truck

1. Please test all decorations before mounting or before plugging into controller.
2. Dump truck comes in two sections.
3. First, set up the largest piece which is Santa in the Dump truck.
4. Next, Directly in front of (basically lapping the other piece) the dump truck, place the individual bed as shown in the picture.
5. The display has a total of 4 male plugs. 2 plugs go to the controller and 2 plugs go to an extension cord.
6. Plug the male plug marked Green 1 into the controller point marked Green 1.
Then plug the male plug marked Red 2 into the controller point marked Red 1.
Plug the controller into an extension cord.
7. The remaining 2 unmarked plugs will also plug into an extension cord.
8. Adjust controller speed to your liking.
